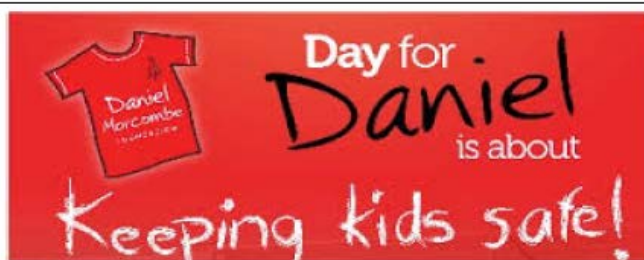

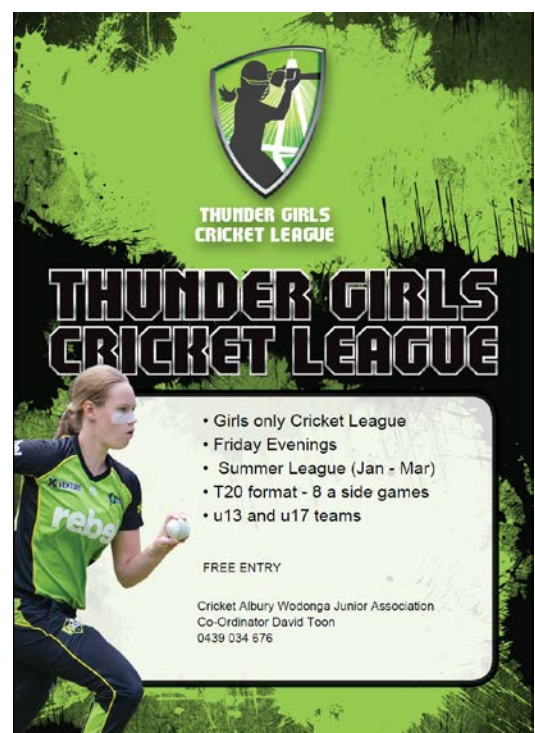

NO STOPPING This sign means that in the area in the direction of the arrow you must not stop your vehicle at any point on the road or kerb, unless there is a medical or other emergency.



These signs mean that in certain areas you may park at the kerb for the time shown on the sign between certain hours and on particular days.



NO PARKING You must not stop for more than two minutes in a No Parking area. You must remain in or within three metres of the vehicle.

Hours of operations may apply to some signs. This means restrictions apply for those times only.
