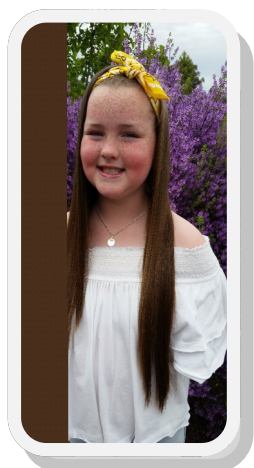
Year 2 Swimming and Water Safety Program

To secure a position for your child, please ensure all payments and permissions forms are returned by Friday 9 November.

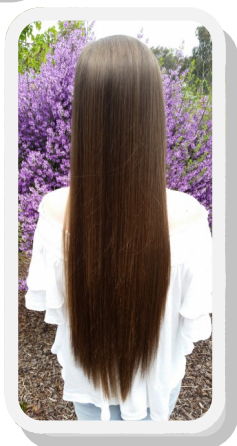
