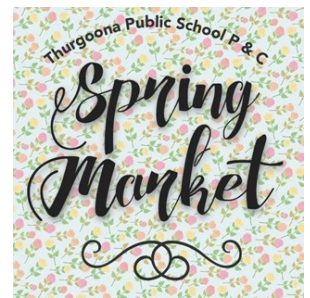


# P&C Fundraising News
