Principals Message

It is six months since Grace Armstrong and past student Joshua Huggard were involved in the official opening of the Albury Recycling Centre. Today they have been invited back to tour the Centre to see how it has changed since the opening. They are being interviewed for a video that is being produced by Albury City Council about the Centre.

Professional Development

All teachers in K-2 classrooms are participating in Language, Learning and Literacy (L3) training this year. L3 is a research-based program for students in K-2, targeting reading and writing. It complements the daily literacy program for students bringing a rich literacy approach into the classroom. Students receive explicit instruction in reading and writing strategies in small groups in a daily literacy lesson. Students then rotate to independent or group tasks. Teachers of L3 complete professional learning throughout a school year including workshops, demonstration lessons, supervised practice and on-the-job support.

Road Safety

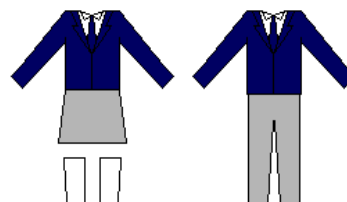
