Tournament of Minds Final

Honours for both teams

On 27 August, two teams of our Stage 3 students showcased their LONG TERM solution to the 2017 Tournament of Minds challenge at the TOM final in Wagga.

Teams were required to work together on a Long Term Challenge for six weeks without assistance from teachers, parents or peers. They were encouraged to explore possibilities and experiment with ideas as they endeavoured to produce their best possible solution. They developed a creative and original way to communicate this solution to others, working within predefined parameters such as limited materials, complex challenge criteria and the deadline of Tournament Day.

Fourteen students worked for 6 weeks on their challenge and finals day was the culmination of many hours of interpretation, research, debate and collaboration, problem solving, strategizing, creating and time management.

Each of the open-ended challenges, which was available for the teams to choose, was based on one of the following disciplines: Science Technology, Engineering Mathematics, Social Sciences and Language Literature.

The **Thurgoona Einstein Team** chose Science Technology and consisted of four students from year six and three students from year 5 – Grace Armstrong, Montana Bartholomew, Jett Harrison, Ryan White, Sam Brownlaw, Olivia Creek and Adam Nicholls.

The **Dillilentiens Team** chose Social Sciences and consisted of four students from year six and three students from year 5 – Emily Cogdell, Ebony Heywood, Rhyanon Kelly, Daniel Harvey, Lucas Cook, Lucas Gunton and Liam Smith.

In addition to the presentation of their Long Term Challenge, each team was required to respond to a spontaneous challenge given on the day of the final.

Our students' first foray into TOM was extremely challenging and rewarding on many levels. CONGRATULATIONS to both teams. Each team was **awarded second place/HONOURS** for their combined scores to the Long Term and Spontaneous challenges. WELL DONE to each team member!!




